


Sentence Types


That won't cost you a DIME to remember!



Declarative

Makes a statement and ends in a period.

Ex. The girl spent her dime on a piece of candy.



Interrogative

Asks a question and ends in a question mark.

Ex. Did the girl pay 10¢ for her candy?



Impervative

Makes a command or request and ends in a period.

Ex. Don't spend your whole dime in one place.



Exclamatory

Shows strong feeling and ends in an exclamation point.

Ex. I can't believe you only paid 10¢ for that candy!
